ELECTORAL ROLL RENEWAL 2019: Every year our Parish Electoral Roll is reviewed so that the names of new people can be added and those of people who have either died or left the area can be deleted.

Every 6 years the entire Electoral Roll is renewed completely and 2019 is one of those years. So, without exception, we must all complete a new application form to join St. Laurence's Electoral Roll. Anyone who is over 16 and has been baptised is eligible.

The notice regarding timing of this process will be displayed in the front porch and application forms will be available at the back of church.

When completed, these forms must be returned to me no later than **Sunday 31st March**. This is to enable a new Electoral Roll to be created in good time for the Annual Parochial Church Meeting on Sunday 28th April.

In his latest message to us, Archbishop Sentamu encourages all of us who qualify to complete one of these forms so that we can all take part in the Church's decision-making at local level. The size of our Electoral Roll determines the number of elected members in the Parochial Church Council and also the number of places we are allowed on the local Deanery Synod.
