THE RAINBOW CENTRE: The Rainbow Centre continues to need 'kettle packs' i.e. packet soup, Mug Shots, instant porridge, Pot Noodles, jars of paste, peanut butter, jam, UHT milk, tinned fruit with ring pull tops and anything that can be made into a meal when all you have is a kettle. Families (many of whom are in work yet still have to claim Universal Credit) also need tinned and packet food, UHT milk, etc. one of their red collection bins is outside the church rooms if you would like to leave donations in there. They are also in need of tinned meat, tinned veg & soup and microwave rice.

WESTWAY OPEN ARMS: VERY MANY THANKS as always for all the donations to WESTWAY OPEN ARMS food bank in Eastfield. The generosity of people is truly amazing and very greatly appreciated - thank you so much. This week we are running VERY LOW in particular of the items listed below:
