WHAT IS A COVENANT SERVICE?

A Covenant Service is a distinctive and cherished act of worship in the Methodist tradition. It is a time when we are invited to renew our relationship with God and recommit ourselves to living as Christ's people.

At the heart of the service is the Covenant Prayer, in which we offer ourselves again to God — trusting in God's grace rather than our own strength. It is an honest and prayerful moment that acknowledges both the joys and challenges of discipleship and calls us to place our whole lives in God's hands.

Held at the beginning of the year, it helps us reflect on where we have been, give thanks for God's faithfulness, and look forward with hope and trust. It reminds us that we do not walk alone, but as part of a covenant community, seeking together to love God and serve others in the name of Christ.

FAITH IN SCARBOROUGH SCHOOLS (FISS) – FIZZYCAN FUNDRAISING

Geoff Boreham will be with us at St Laurence's on Sunday 1st February to collect in FIZZYCANS and share news of FIZZ – Faith in Scarborough Schools. FISS is a Christian charity and has been working to promote the Christian faith in Scarborough schools since 1998. It has three paid workers and does not charge any of the schools for the presentations and materials they give to the children. All income to enable FISS's ministry comes from donations and grants and FISSYCANs help with both raising funds and awareness of their work. They are designed for you to collect and donate loose change. Each FISSYCAN contains a GiftAid form and instructions on how to register it so that FISS are aware of where the cans have been given a home.
